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Taking Care Of My Wife

Typically, caregiver spouses are paid between \$10.75 - \$20.75 / hour. In general terms, to be eligible as a care recipient for these programs, applicants are limited to approximately \$27,756 per year in income, and most programs limit the value of their countable assets to less than \$2,000.

Some states also allow a spouse to be the paid caregiver. Each state has its own eligibility requirements and name for its program. If your older adult is accepted into the state’s program, the amount of money they receive will depend on a Medicaid assessment of need and the average state wage for in-home care aides.

Getting Paid as a Family Caregiver: 3 Government Benefits ...

The care recipient will need to let CDPAP know about his/her needs and get a doctor’s authorization. You, their care provider, must submit evidence that you’re legally allowed to work in the U.S. You also need to get a physical and bloodwork done to demonstrate you’re healthy enough to provide care.

10 Ways to Get Paid While Taking Care of a Family Member

A spouse who stays home to care for healthy children while the other spouse continues to work is still not entitled to Social Security until age 62. However, if the child is disabled and receiving his own Social Security benefit, the caregiver parent can qualify for benefits at any age based on the working parent's record.
